THE PROGRAM

The Girton Grammar Drama program provides students with an education in all aspects of drama, theatre production and performance. Through specialist trained teachers, rigorous curriculum content and a range of field trips to experience professional theatre here and abroad, students are immersed in the Performing Arts industry in Bendigo, Australia and the world.

The Drama subjects in the senior years sit alongside a huge array of co-curricular Drama opportunities in both the Junior School and Senior School.

Facilities include a Performing Arts building with a fully equipped and much-loved “Black Box” theatre, a number of private music tuition rooms, plus a dance studio. The Junior School Hall is magically transformed into a theatre with the full suite of professional sound and lighting equipment, to give every student a taste of the big time!

Every year there are grand-scale theatre productions, performed at Bendigo’s renowned Ulumburra or Capital Theatres, giving students a “real-life” opportunity to experience a professional theatre environment.

With Bendigo's largest Performing Arts program, there is a creative opportunity for every student. From Prep through to Year 12 students are given several opportunities each year to perform. This includes our Junior and Senior School Productions, Year 8 Production as well as the "End of Year Spectacular".
